- In electricity, electric force is the attraction or repulsion between electric charges.
- The buildup of charges on an object is called static electricity.
- The law of conservation of charge states that charges are not created or destroyed. They are transferred.
- The transfer of charge from one object to another by rubbing is called friction.
- The loss of static electricity as electric charges transfer from one object to another is called static discharge.
- A(n) electric field is a region around a charged object where the object's electric force is exerted on other charged objects.
- The transfer of electrons from one part of an object to another part, caused by the electric field of another object, without the two objects touching is called induction.
- The transfer of charge when electrons move from a charged object to another object by direct contact is called conduction.
